Steve indicated the 6/24 scheduled CAP Study Public Hearing was expected To be rescheduled in July to avoid conflicts with other events/meetings.

1. CAP Study: Draft Technical Memorandum #1 – Existing Conditions Inventory (Jan 2008).

“Planned Multi-Use Trail” on the North side of the creek/ South side of Main Street on Bicycle & Pedestrian Facilities

2. CAP Study: Draft Technical Memorandum #2 – Needs & Opportunities Assessment (Mar 2008).

“Multi-Use Improvements” on south side of creek with bridge.

The above documents were discussed at the public meeting.

David Sliney indicated that the study would benefit the Village in many ways. Many interesting facts, for example, the stop light on Main St in front of Pliant & Gravino Park, may not be NYS DOT installed and currently does not serve Gravino Park. An opportunity could be to change the entrance to Gravino Park to line up with the stoplight.
